Dear Parents,

Welcome to another year of Eldon Mustang sporting events. In an effort to maintain a safe and orderly environment at our home events, please review these with your children and assist us in enforcing the following expectations:

### 7th & 8th Grade Students

- All 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students must sit in the designated section. They can also sit with their parents.
- All 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students must be seated during the game. Do not wander around stadium or gyms.
- Students should return to their seat after going to the concession stand, which is located next to the middle school seating section.
- Do not bring footballs, soccer balls, kick balls, etc. to the stadiums or gyms. They will be confiscated by game supervisors. There is no ball playing, tag games, etc. allowed in the stadium or on the fields behind the stadium, or in the gyms.
- Do not stand along railings. Sit in a seat with parents.
- Always exhibit good sportsmanship:
  - Quietly stand during the National Anthem
  - Stand and clap along with the School Fight Song, "The Victors."
  - Cheer for the players when their names are announced.
  - Join in the positive cheering for the Mustangs.
  - Represent Eldon in a positive manner – do not yell at officials or opposing players.
- Remember, you should be going to the game to watch the game. This will help you become a better player and fan yourself!

These expectations are not being made to discourage attendance by anyone, but rather an attempt to promote student safety and to make everyone feel welcome and eager to attend Mustang events.
